At WJU, modern language majors choose to specialize in either French or Spanish and are required to study abroad for at least one semester. Romance language majors combine the study of French and Spanish, the students select which of the two languages will be the major areas of concentration and which will be the minor. There is no requirement to study abroad.

A modern language major combine with a second field of concentration such as international studies, teacher preparation, international business or professional writing give students competitive edges over other candidates in the global marketplace of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
